CHSA continues to strive to meet your needs and provide you with updated information regarding your workers compensation insurance program. Safe work practices and Safety training are important components in injury prevention and in keeping your workers compensation premiums under control.

CHSA has developed a second safety training DVD and training guide to be utilized in training your stable employees. You will be provided with a copy of the training video. We request your participation in showing the video and implementing safety training with your staff, this is a required compliance for the workers compensation subsidy, rate schedule credit, and incentive programs provided by the CTBL.

On that respect, CHSA also holds safety meetings at Santa Anita, Hollywood Park, Pomona, Golden Gate Fields and Pleasanton. Your employees are provided with safety topics, view the video, and earn prizes for correctly answering the safety quiz. Twice a year grand prizes and Award of Excellence are awarded to stable employees that actively participate in safety training and that show a commitment to safety and have not incurred any lost time from work for a work related accident or injury.

Trainers with most active participation from their stable employees and a commitment to safety in their barns are also awarded the Award of Excellence.

Due to a reduction in the number of participants at our monthly safety meetings, CHSA will now hold the meetings at your individual barn.
